## Keep Tucson Work Areas Safe: Prevent Falls & Hazards

<b>Sweep &amp; Clear Work Zones</b> Regularly remove dust and debris from walking surfaces on the job site.	<b>Wear Slip-Resistant Footwear</b> Choose boots rated for Tucson's outdoor terrain – rocky, sandy, and unpredictable.	<b>Keep Walkways Clear</b> Remove mud, tools, and materials from entrances and pedestrian routes.	<b>Report Hazards Immediately</b> Uneven surfaces, wet spots, or debris – report it before someone gets hurt.
